FACTS:

- Parties must place on record the undisputed facts, not exceeding 1 page.

SUBMISSIONS:

- Table of Statement of Claims/Counter-Claims as placed before Arbitral Tribunal

Claim/Counter Claim No. (with content of the Claim)	Amount claimed	Amount awarded along with direction of the Tribunal

- Written Submissions, if directed by the court, to not exceed more than 4 pages (not including the aforesaid Table), font: Times New Roman, size 12, line spacing 1.15 and page size A4.
- The written submissions shall specifically address the precise nature of the dispute arising for consideration, the findings rendered by the Tribunal, claim-wise and counter claim wise (if any), along with the reasons assigned by the Tribunal for arriving at such conclusions, as well as the grounds on which the Petitioner contends that interference with the arbitral award is warranted along with the relevant sub-clause of Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996.
- Mention corresponding PDF page numbers only.
