



**C I R C U L A R**

In continuation of previous Circular F. No. 2(B)/Comp./DHC/1319 dated 7<sup>th</sup> November, 2013 regarding mandatory e-filing in Company and Tax matters w.e.f. 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2013, it is clarified that even in pending Company and Tax matters (not filed through e-filing), the Registry will accept counter affidavits, rejoinder affidavits, applications, documents, etc. through e-filing only. It is also made clear that appeals, petitions, etc. in Company and Tax matters lying under objection will be filed through e-filing only.
